A squaddled meeting of 60 shots at 50m will be held at the East Court Range, E Grinstead on the 17th & 18th September 1994. A map will be sent on request.

COMPETITORS

Open to all members of clubs affiliated to the NSRA.

CLASSIFICATION

Competitors will be classified on the best 10 of the last 12 indoor county cards. Those who have not shot Match cards will be classified on the best 10 of the last 12 cards shot on NSRA 1989 cards. Scores must be certified by a Club Official. Those competitors who do not enter scores will be placed in class A. The organisers reserve the right to reclassify any competitor.

CLASSES

There will be four classes as follows:

CLASS A: 97.5 and over CLASS B: 95.0 to 97.4
CLASS C: 92.5 to 94.9 CLASS D: 92.4 and below

Ladies, Juniors and Veterans Handicaps will be shot under the Dropped Points System.

Badge Competition: A badge competition is included in the entry fee.

Badges may be claimed on payment of £4.50(inc Class flash). Additional class flashes £1.25.

PRIZES

These will consist of Returnable Trophies for the winners in each of the main classes. Non-returnable plaques to be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class and to the winners of the Ladies, Juniors and Veteran Handicaps, as well as the Club Pairs.
All prizes will be on display in the Club Room. Prizes will be presented at approximately 5.30pm on Sunday 18th September.

TARGETS

The three card system will be used. **PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN TARGET CLIPS** (a minimum of 12 are required).

RULES

Subject to this programme, NSRA rules will apply. Disputes will be settled by a Committee of three persons appointed by the Club. The Committee's decision shall be final. A minimum of three entries will be required in comps 5 and 6.

DETAILS

Times of Shooting 10.00 to 16.30 both days. Competitors must check in not less than 10 minutes before commencement of their details. Each squad will consist of three 20 minute details with 5 minutes between to change targets. There will be a 10 minute interval between each squad. No competitor may go forward of the firing point without the permission of the Range Officer. A whistle will be sounded at the start and end of each shooting period. **BREECH FLAGS MUST BE USED.**
NO RIFLE TO BE RAISED TO THE FIRING POSITION BETWEEN SHOOTING PERIODS.

CHALLENGES

A challenge must be accompanied by a fee of £1, refundable if the challenge is successful.

CAR PARK

There is a car park at the range.

REFRESHMENTS

Light refreshments will be served in the clubhouse each day.

AMMUNITION

Ammunition will be on sale. A FAC will be required for purchases of 100 rounds or more.

GENERAL

Competitors are required to check that their scores are entered before leaving the range. All targets and backers must be clearly marked with: **COMPETITORS No, DETAIL LETTER AND FIRING POINT NUMBER.**
