**COMPETITORS/
CLASSIFICATION** Open to all members of clubs affiliated to the NSRA. Competitors will be classified on the best 10 of the last 12 indoor county cards. Those who have not shot Match cards will be classified on the best 10 of the last 12 cards shot on NSRA 1989 cards. Scores must be certified by the Club Secretary or Captain. Those competitors who do not enter scores will be placed in class A.

CLASSES Competitions 1 to 4 will each be shot in Classes as follows:
CLASS A: 97.7 and over CLASS B: 96.1 to 97.6
CLASS C: 93.8 to 96.0 CLASS D: 93.7 and below

PRIZES There will be prizes (mainly silver-plate and pewter) awarded as follows:
Competitions 1, 2 & 4: A prize for the winner in each class.
Competition 3: A first, second and third prize in each class.
Competitions 5, 6 & 7: A first prize and other prizes according to entry.
Competitions 8 and 9: A prize for each member of the winning team.
Inner Carton Pool: 75% of the entry money will be distributed among competitors with 7 or more inner cartons per 20 shot card.
Sweepstake: 75% of the entry money will be distributed among competitors who have shot the best 20 shot cards.

In addition there will be **RETURNABLE** trophies awarded to the winners of selected competitions. All trophies and prizes will be on display in the Club Room. Trophies and Prizes will be presented at approximately 6.00 pm on Sunday 17th April.

TARGETS The three card system will be used. **PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN TARGET CLIPS** (a minimum of 12 are required).

RULES Subject to this programme, NSRA rules will apply. Disputes will be settled by a Committee of three persons appointed by the Club. The Committee's decision shall be final.

DETAILS Competitors must check in not less than 10 minutes before commencement of their details. Each detail will commence on the hour and half hour with 10 minutes for target changing, followed by 20 minutes shooting time. No competitor may go forward of the firing point without the permission of the Range Officer. A whistle will be sounded at the start and end of each shooting period. **BREECHES FLAGS MUST BE USED AND NO RIFLE RAISED TO THE FIRING POSITION BETWEEN SHOOTING PERIODS.**

CROSS SHOOTING A competitor firing at another competitors card will be credited with the value of the cross shot, but will incur a penalty of 2 points for each cross shot. Remember that if you put a shot on someone else's card you must put 19 shots on your card.

CHALLENGES £1.00 per challenge - refunded if upheld.

CAR PARK There is a car park at the range.

REFRESHMENTS Light refreshments, including the infamous Felbridge bacon butty, will be served in the clubhouse each day.

AMMUNITION Ammunition will be available for purchase in the Stats Office. A FAC will be required for purchases of 100 or more rounds.

GENERAL Competitors are required to check that their scores are entered before leaving the range. All targets and backers must be clearly marked with: **COMPETITORS No, DETAIL LETTER AND FIRING POINT No.**
